

# Western Australian Public Libraries Online Book Club



*The Online Book Club is similar to in-person book clubs but runs online. Three books are available concurrently for a period of nine weeks, updated five times throughout the year.*

## **Step 2: How to access Book Club discussion books for free**



### **FREADING APP - Free access to Book Club titles**

Customers can now choose their library in the **Freeding** app to download the ebook titles. Please note an **Adobe Digital Editions account** is required to sign in to download.

1. Download the **Freeding** app from Google Play or Apple App Store
2. Choose '**Get Books**' from the bottom menu
3. Tap '**Login**' button
4. Select '**Australia**' as the country from the drop down menu, and tap '**Find Library**'
5. Libraries already setup will appear under the name '**Book Club**'
6. Tap on relevant library, enter card number, and tap login below the box
7. Titles may expire during the book club duration - customers can re-download the titles



**NOTE : Book Club titles may also be accessed from your local library or via *BorrowBox* or *Libby*.**

## Step 3: How to access the Book Club discussion forum

The book club will have a moderator from PBC Guru who manages the forum where discussions occur online. The moderator will pose questions to the book club, share relevant articles and facilitate conversation about topics in the book. Members will be encouraged to post and share as well. This format allows for ongoing conversation and makes it easy for readers to connect with each other through the forum.

### **DISCOURSE APP - Free access to the Book Club discussion forum**

Customers download the **Discourse** or **DiscourseHub** app to get access to the online discussion forum.

1. Download the **Discourse** app from Google Play or Apple App Store
2. Click on the '+' button in the upper left-hand corner
3. You will be prompted to add the book club forum's URL
4. The URL is: **<https://waplibrary.pbc.guru>**
5. Click the '**connect**' button
6. You will then be prompted to **login** using your **book club email** and **password** that you used to create your account.
7. Now you have access to the book club forum!
